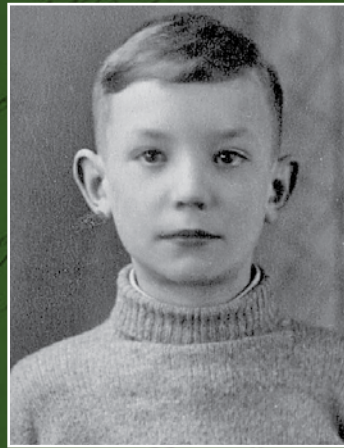


Gordon Carr is a Yorkshire lad through and through. Starting from rather humble beginnings but now in his 80s, he has certainly led a life more convoluted than most.

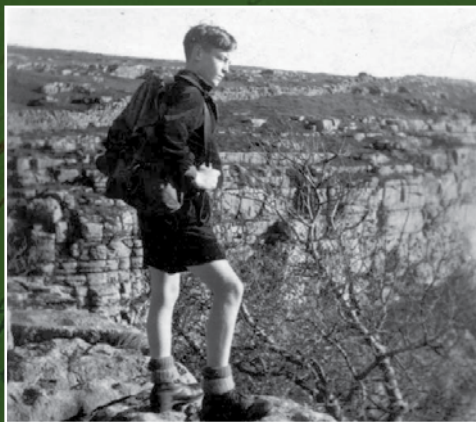
